

The Ditidaht Development Corporation in partnership with the Ditidaht Natural Resource Office is offering positions for the 2020 seasonal operations, maintenance, specie at risk monitoring and hiker interaction on the Ditidaht traditional lands and sea along the West Coast Trail.

The duties will include but are not limited to:

- Early seasonal brushing and clearing of West Coast Trail as well as ongoing brushing, minor repairs and maintenance of board walk structures.
- interaction with hikers and campers along the West Coast Trail and share Ditidaht First Nation culture and history.
- Monitoring of Species-at Risk-including the Southern Killer whale.
- Assistance in set-up, dismantling and maintain of Comfort Camping tents, cabins and guardian domes as well as the maintaining of site grounds and facilities.

Candidates with experience in trail construction, boat operation and safety procedures and/or maintenance or Interpretation the West Coast Trail is an asset. Physical fitness is a criteria as you will be required to hike the trail on a daily basis, pack gear and supplies use brushing and clearing equipment and chop firewood. Specific training will be provided.

Willingness to work long shift including weekends, evenings and statutory holidays on the trail, take direction and supervision and carry out duties with little or no direct daily supervision will also be required.
