

POWER OUTAGE NOTICE


BC Hydro has planned system maintenance.

Asaabuus Daycare News and Reminders

We are happy to announce that we were successful in yet another proposal grant we have applied for from the First Peoples Cultural Council. We are going to go big with this funding and reach a 4 hr/day, full language immersion program for the fall for our daycare children, pre k and kindergartens as well. We are in partnership with the school and we will all be thankfully working towards this goal as one, with our elders support and knowledge. I am proud and grateful for our plans and for the commitment from all the staff in reaching this goal with our full potential. I have faith in our team to make this dream a reality. This extra cultural funding will be for the next 2 years, so I'm hoping to show them something amazing so that we can keep this going after the 2 years is up.

Also, a reminder, please make sure children are picked up before 4:45 so that closing staff can tend to their closing tidy and set up routines. If you know you won't be able to pick up at this time, please arrange an alternate pick up for your child and assure the staff knows who the pick up person will be.
