Friendly Reminder to be safe on the roads during this winter season!

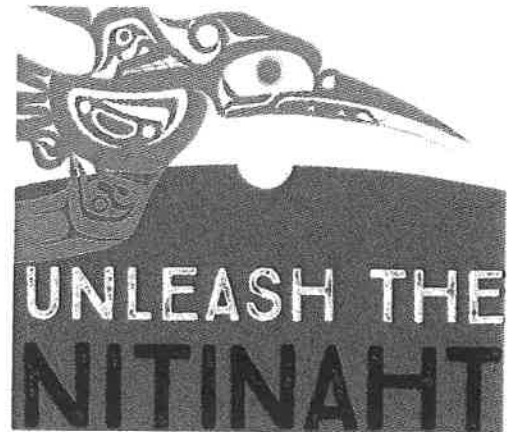
- Notify family or a friend of your departure and/or arrival time.

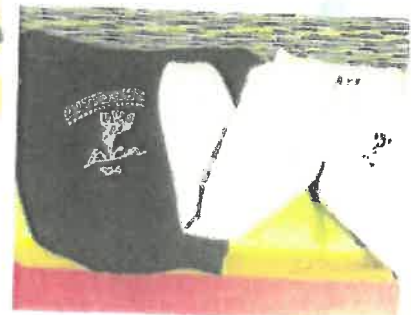

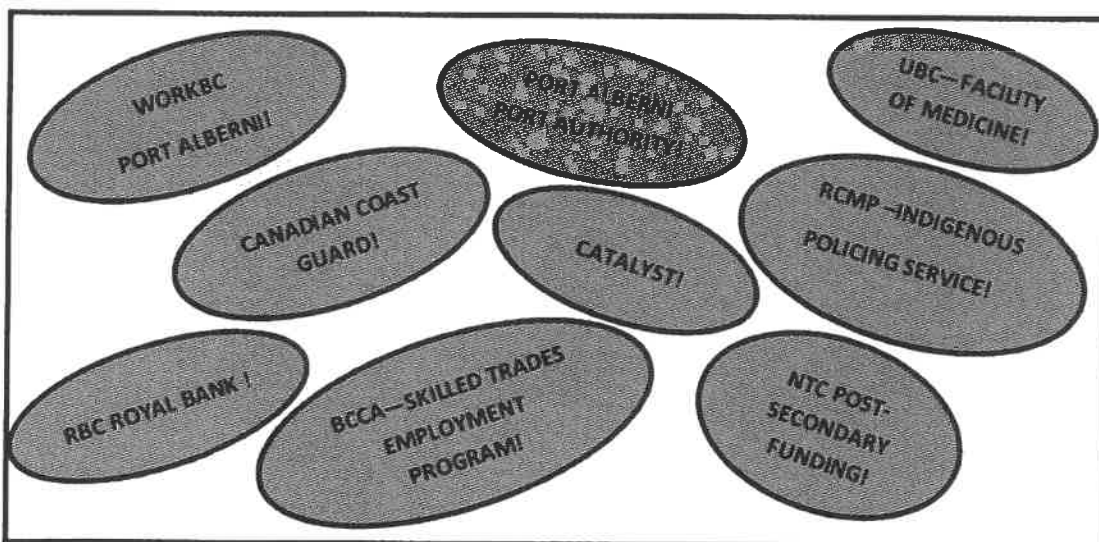
