Teechuktl Regional Coordinator

An opportunity for rewarding work that is rich in indigenous culture, and experience recreational activities among scenic mountain vistas and waterways.

The Nuu-chah-nulth Tribal Council's is seeking a full-time Teechuktl (mental health) Regional Coordinator for the Northern Region. This position is responsible for coordinating mental health services to remote communities within the region. Based out of the Northern Region Office (Gold River), the Teechuktl Regional Coordinator will also supervise Teechuktl staff, and work closely with other NTC departments and community staff to provide mutually supportive services.

Responsibilities will include:

- To coordinate service delivery in the regions, with a focus on counselling supervision, community development, promoting mental wellness, promoting cultural awareness, and program administration.
- Develop, organize, and deliver workshops and programs including suicide prevention
- To be aware of overall mental health service needs in the region as well as short-term critical needs
- To supervise workers to deliver consistent service within a framework inclusive of professional skills and Quu'asa values

Preferred Qualifications:

- Degree in a field related to counselling and recover, plus five years front-line experience in coordination and supervision
- Familiarity with Nuu-chah-nulth First Nations culture and healing processes
- Experience in programs to facilitate transformation from addictions
- An established plan for self-care
- Must have a car and valid driver's licence
- Provide acceptable references and criminal record check
