## Employment Opportunity

The Ditidaht First Nation is looking for an energetic, self-motivated individual to serve as a temporary Education Outreach Worker.

This term position will be part of a team, working with the Project Manager and a Committee to understand the learning needs and ideas of our membership and to participate in developing an overarching Community Learning Strategy.

The Education Outreach Worker will assist in engaging members of all ages in discussing their experiences, knowledge, interests, and vision for learning support systems inside and outside of our community. They will be involved in interviews and focus groups with our members, administration, school staff, leadership and resource people. They will also be involved in community meetings and family visits work in collaboration with other DFN staff, including Treaty.

The Education Outreach Worker reports directly to the Project Manager. The role involves learning on the job, including skills in interviewing, facilitation, data collection, analysis and computers.

The position calls for strong interpersonal skills, strong oral and written skills and an interest and willingness to learn through doing.

Start and End Dates: Mid September until end of day Friday, March 29<sup>th</sup>.

Hours: The hours of work are Monday through Friday, 8:30 am to 4:30 pm with some flexibility to allow for various scheduling issues as they arise (e.g., community meetings).
